Angus Carrick Update: January 05, 2024

This was a long stage between O Cádavo and Lugo so we walked to Castroverde and got a bus to Lugo, the largest city on the Camino Primitivo, which is famous for its Roman wall and the Cathedral of Santa María. We set the alarm for six in the morning, had a quick breakfast and went off at first light. We had intended to take an alternative to the main camino, but missed it somehow, which was lucky because we got to Castroverde quickly on a mixture of newly prepared tracks and old walled paths. Once there, we had coffee with fellow pilgrims and got a stamp from the council office, but more interestingly a stamp from the photo shop where the lady then opened the church for us and showed us around. Santiago (Saint James) is also the patron saint of Castroverde, and in the church there was a statue of him on horseback putting muslims to the sword. This statue is carried around the town by six men on his saint's day. We made our way to the bus stop by the pizza bar and had coffee and chocolate pastry, before squeezing onto a packed bus to Lugo. We were glad we had taken the bus when we saw the long busy road the bus took through built up areas to get to the edge of the old town, and we got there just in time for Sue to go to mass and Angus to check out the tourist office and sit in the shade to do some planning. After that, we went together to the exhibition above the tourist office about the origins of the town, its roman walls and its history to the modern day. Hungry after all this activity, we found a pizza restaurant, a rarity in this part of the world and enjoyed a meal. Thus strengthened, we walked round the 2km on top of the walls on a broad track, meeting Monika, an Estonian lady we had met earlier on the Camino. We had been
